Visa Student ³	£4,000 – set off against first term fees in the second year of study ⁴	We must receive the Overseas Deposit before we can issue a Confirmation of Acceptance for Study (CAS). ⁵ We can only issue a CAS a maximum of three months prior to the start of your programme. Award	Criteria	Application
Up to £2,000 for each year of study	Merit based – awarded by reference to actual or predicted grades and performance at interview	Students in receipt of an offer are automatically considered for a scholarship – details of which will be included in any offer letter

PAYMENT

Individual payment schedule

There are a number of ways you can pay your fees:

- Annually: payable on or before 1st September
- Termly: 3 equal installments on 15th September, 15th January and 15th April
- Monthly: 11 monthly instalments - starting in September and ending in July

Your actual payment to the College will be dependent on whether you have obtained a student loan, are awarded a scholarship and/or bursary.

The College can, on request, supply students who have accepted an offer of a place with an individual payment schedule, taking into account any preferred method of payment and any
