FEES

Deposit

	Amount	Payable
UK/EU/EEA and Swiss bond	£500	On acceptance and returned at the end of study net of any outstanding fees owed to the College.

Tuition Fees

	Amount	Payable
UK/EU/EEA and Swiss fee	£9,250 per annum	The annual tuition fee must be paid by 1 September or in accordance with any agreed payment plan (see the Payment section of this document).

Scholarships³

Award	Criteria	Application
Up to £2,000 for each year of study.	Merit based – awarded by reference to actual or predicted grades and performance at interview.	Students in receipt of an offer are automatically considered for a scholarship – details of which will be included in any offer letter.

Bursaries⁴

Award	Criteria	Application
There are up to 15 part bursary awards each year. Awards are up to £3,085 (at October 2017) per annum for each year of study.	Means-based assessment	All students who are in receipt of an offer will be sent information on how to apply for bursaries.

³ The award of a scholarship in subsequent years of study is conditional on both satisfactory attendance and academic performance.

⁴ Bursaries are awarded by reference to objective means-based criteria as applied by the College's Bursary Committee. To be considered for a full or part bursary, a candidate will need to supply sufficient financial information for each year of study in order to be assessed. The award of any bursary is conditional on both satisfactory attendance and academic performance.

PAYMENT

Individual payment schedule

There are a number of ways you can pay your fees:

- Annually: payable on or before 1st September
- Termly: 3 equal installments on 15th September, 15th January and 15th April
- Monthly: 11 monthly instalments - starting in September and ending in July

Your actual payment to the College will be dependent on whether you have obtained a student loan, are awarded a scholarship and/or bursary.

The College can, on request, supply students who have accepted an offer of a place with an individual payment schedule, taking into account any preferred method of payment and any external and internal financial support that may apply.
