FEES

Overseas Deposit (students requiring a visa to study in the UK)

	Visa Deposit	Payable
Visa Student ³	£4,000 – set off against first term fees in the second year of study ⁴	We must receive the Overseas Deposit before we can issue a Confirmation of Acceptance for Study (CAS). ⁵ We can only issue a CAS a maximum of three months prior to the start of your programme. 	Amount	Payable
International Fee	£14,000 per annum	The annual tuition fee must be paid by 1 September or in accordance with any agreed payment plan (see the Payment section of this document).

NCH SUPPORT

Scholarships

Scholarships awards are assessed yearly. As such, any initial award is for the first academic year only. Awards in subsequent academic years are conditional on both satisfactory attendance (of at least 70%) and academic performance (minimum of 2:1 average).

Award	Criteria	Application
Up to £2,000 for each year of study	Merit based – awarded by reference to actual or predicted grades and performance at interview	Students in receipt of an offer are automatically considered for a scholarship – details of which will be included in any offer letter

PAYMENT

Individual payment schedule

There are a number of ways you can pay your fees:

- Annually: payable on or before 1 September
- Termly: 3 equal installments on 15 September, 15 January and 15 April
- Monthly: 11 monthly instalments - starting in September and ending in July

Your actual payment to the College will be dependent on whether you have obtained any internal or external funding.

The College can, on request, supply students who have accepted an offer of a place with an individual payment schedule, taking into account any preferred method of payment and any external and internal financial support that may apply.
