#### TUITION FEES

	Amount	Payable
UK/EU/EEA and Swiss fee	£9,250 per annum	The annual tuition fee must be paid by 1 September or in accordance with any agreed payment plan (see the Payment section of this document).

#### FINANCIAL SUPPORT

##### Student Finance

Most students from England, Scotland and Northern Ireland, as well as EU nationals and those who have lived in the EEA or Switzerland, can apply for a tuition fee loan from Student Finance – which for 2019 entry - will be a minimum of £6,165. Please note that the College is required – along with all higher education providers – to apply for registration with a new regulator, the Office for Students. The outcome of this registration process may result in College students being able to access higher levels of student finance for 2019 entry. The College will keep you updated.

### NCH Support<sup>3</sup>

NCH offers further financial support via scholarships and bursaries. Below is an outline of these schemes. Further information can be provided by the Admission Team at: [admissions@nchlondon.ac.uk](mailto:admissions@nchlondon.ac.uk)

#### Scholarships

Scholarships awards are assessed yearly. As such, any initial award is for the first academic year only. Awards in subsequent academic years are conditional on both satisfactory attendance (of at least 75%) and academic performance (minimum of 2:1 average).

Award	Criteria	Application
Up to £2,000 for each year of study.	Merit based – awarded by reference to actual or predicted grades and performance at interview.	Students in receipt of an offer are automatically considered for a scholarship – details of which will be included in any offer letter.

#### Bursaries

Bursaries are awarded yearly by reference to objective means-based criteria as applied by the College’s Bursary Committee. To be considered for a full or part bursary, a candidate will need to supply sufficient financial information/evidence for each year of study in order to be assessed. Awards are also dependent on satisfactory attendance (of at least 70%).

Award	Criteria	Application
There are up to 25 bursary awards each year. Awards are up to £2,000 (at October 2018) per annum for each year of study.	Means-based assessment	All students who are in receipt of an offer will be sent information on how to apply for bursaries.

## PAYMENT

### Individual payment schedule

There are a number of ways you can pay your fees:

- Annually: payable on or before 1 September
- Termly: 3 equal instalments on 15 September, 15 January and 15 April
- Monthly: 11 monthly instalments - starting in September and ending in July

Your actual payment to the College will be dependent on whether you have obtained a student loan, are awarded a scholarship and/or bursary.

<sup>3</sup> Students can receive both a scholarship and bursary award, although no combined award can exceed £2,000 per annum.
