The role

The New College of Humanities at Northeastern wishes to appoint a part-time Lecturer (Teaching) in Philosophy (Sustainability and Technology).

We wish to appoint specialists in Technology and Sustainability who are able to deliver teaching appropriately at the level of a pre-university summer school. Preference may be given to candidates with active interests in the relationship of technology and sustainability to one or more of the following areas: software and/or technology; employment contexts; diversity and inclusion.

Core duties will include the preparation and delivery of Philosophy-related classes, as well as the overall coordination of the brief interdisciplinary summer school Sustainability, Technology, and the Future. The classes will be delivered between 29 July and 6 August (both dates inclusive).

We particularly encourage applications from those with an interest in innovative teaching, learning and assessment; those with experience of supporting a wide variety of students; and those belonging to groups underrepresented in UK higher education. We are open to appointing on a reduced fraction/job-share basis subject to our business needs.

All appointments are subject to a DBS check, which will be a condition of appointment.
