### FEES

#### Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) Deposit

4. Students requiring a visa to study at the College, will need to be provided with a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) in order to apply for a visa. Before the College will be able to issue your CAS it needs to be satisfied of your intention to study and does this by requiring you to pay a deposit (the CAS Deposit) – this is in line with the practice in UK higher education. Below is an outline of the conditions relating to the CAS Deposit.

Visa Student	£3,000	We must receive the CAS Deposit before we can issue a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS). We can only issue a CAS a maximum of six months prior to the start of your programme. 5. The CAS Deposit is set off against first term fees.<sup>2</sup>

<sup>2</sup> If paying yearly, the CAS Deposit will be deducted from the first-year payment. Where paying termly, the CAS Deposit will be set off against the first term's fees. If paying monthly, the CAS Deposit will be offset equally across the first year's instalments.

6. The CAS Deposit is generally non-refundable or transferrable, however, the circumstances in which the CAS Deposit may be repaid (in whole or part) are as outlined in the [Cancellation, Withdrawal, Refund and Compensation Policy](#).
