### Student Finance

5. Most students from England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland can apply for a tuition fee loan.

## PAYMENT

### Individual payment schedule

8. There are a number of ways you can pay your fees:
  - Annually: payable on or before 30 September
  - Termly: 3 equal instalments on 30 September, 13 January and 14 April
  - Monthly: 10 monthly instalments - starting in September and ending in June
9. Your actual payment to the College will be dependent on whether you have obtained a student loan, are awarded a scholarship and/or bursary. Details of this are contained within the [Scholarship and Bursary Policy](#).

The College can, on request, supply students who have accepted an offer of a place with an individual payment schedule, taking into account any preferred method of payment and any external and internal financial support that may apply.
